

- 1. Log into Show Manager (or create an account)
- 2. From the menu click on 'My Area' then select 'My Dogs'
- 3. From the list of Dogs, click on the **Edit** for the Dog that you want to edit. This will take you to a details page for the selected Dog.
- 4. From the menu click on **Pedigree**
- 5. Enter the 3 generation pedigree for the selected dog.
- 6. Click on 'Save'

NB: Check your dog's other details while you are there

- have you added any recent titles your dog may have obtained?
- are the ownership details correct?

The details entered for your dog, is what will appear in the catalogue.

#### Exercising Dogs / Off Leash Area

There is plenty of grass areas throughout the venue, we ask all exhibitors to ensure they clean up after their dogs.

No dogs are to exercised in the following areas on the showground:

- The main arena (large circular fenced arena).
- Obedience ring (cattle judging ground) prior to or during the judging of obedience on Monday.
- Show ring (Exhibition Pavilion).
- Designated camping areas.

Anyone exercising their dogs on any of the grounds MUST clean up after their dogs. Failure to do so will jeopardise <u>us and other clubs</u> using these venues in the future.
